Jamie's Farm

next farm near Skipton,
Yorkshire. Set in sweeping
countryside on the south
of the Yorkshire Dales, the
extensive farm will host
young people from
across the region
and beyond.

We will initially be offering a programme of day visits, with visiting young people attending the farm once a week over a six week half term. This will provide young people with an extended Jamie's Farm intervention, focusing on their engagement with school, attendance and mental wellbeing. This programme would be ideal either as a stand-alone intervention, or as a follow-up programme to many of the pupils who have already attended our residentials at other Jamie's Farms.

What we're offering

- Weekly visits to the farm, promoting long term engagement with school
- Extensive working farm with hundreds of sheep, cows and chickens
- Set in beautiful rolling countryside, providing fresh air, views and peace
- Visiting groups will support with seasonal work such as farming, cooking, woodwork and gardening
- · A warm, family environment, providing a big welcome, individual connection and effective nurture from our skilled and experienced staff team

 Programme underpinned by therapeutic principles of empathy, unconditional positive regard and authentic relationships

 Ideal for groups of 9 young people, supported by 2 school staff, who are currently strugaling to have their needs met in school
